







The **VetPet Health** Summit

Session 1: Animal Health

Animal health encompasses the well-being of animals—physical, mental, and social. It's vital for livestock, pets, preventing zoonotic diseases, and ethical treatment. This session highlights the latest research, prevention, and treatments in animal health. Experts from veterinary medicine and related fields will discuss current status and future developments.

Session 2: Animal Vaccination

The government's new policy focuses on immunizing livestock against diseases like Brucellosis, Foot & Mouth Disease, Avian Influenza, African Swine Fever, and Porcine Reproductive and Respiratory Syndrome Virus. However, challenges like infrastructure, storage costs, and a shortage of skilled professionals persist. This session highlights the importance of animal vaccination and explores solutions to these challenges.

Session 3: Animal Diagnostics

The global veterinary diagnostics market is set to reach \$6.5 billion by 2025. Factors include a growing animal population, pet adoption, and increased healthcare costs. Improved diagnostics are crucial for better disease understanding and animal health worldwide. The market's growth is expected to continue, driven by cost reduction and a rising demand for targeted therapies. Discover the future of animal diagnostics and growth opportunities in India.

Session 4: Veterinary Radiology

Veterinary radiology employs imaging technologies like radiography, ultrasonography, CT, and MRI to diagnose and treat conditions in animals. Digital radiography, ultrasound, CT, and nuclear medicine are gaining significance, with ongoing research promising future advancements in veterinary medicine.

Session 5: Veterinary Parasitology

Veterinary Parasitology explores the relationship between parasites and animal hosts, including domestic and wildlife species. Through research and various methods, it diagnoses, treats, and prevents animal parasites, benefiting both animal husbandry and public health. This session focuses on recent research in epidemiology, disease treatment, and prevention strategies for parasitic infections in domestic and wild animals, promoting advancements in the field.

Session 6 : Animal Dermatology

Veterinary dermatology extends beyond treating rashes, encompassing diverse skin diseases across species. Specialists require expertise in various treatments and training in internal medicine, immunology, and allergies, as skin issues can often relate to underlying health problems.

Session 7: Veterinary Dentistry

Veterinary Dentistry focuses on animal dental care, notably addressing periodontal disease, a common issue in dogs and cats. Early prevention is crucial, as even young pets can develop this condition. Unfortunately, dental pain often goes unnoticed. The veterinary dental equipment market, worth \$306 million in 2022, is projected to reach \$537.5 million by 2032, growing at a 5.8% CAGR from 2023. Explore the latest developments in veterinary dentistry and their adoption in the Indian market.

Session 8: Zoonotic & Infectious Diseases

Zoonoses are infectious diseases that transfer from animals to humans, often involving bacteria, viruses, or parasites. Transmission can occur through direct contact, contaminated food, water, or the environment.
